Tasting Note: AltaCima 4.090 refers to the height of the Peteroa Volcano that overlooks our vineyards from the Andes Mountains range. This Gewürztraminer has floral aromas of rose petals together with exotic lychee, apricot, lime and spice. On the palate its refreshing and mineral fruitiness is accompanied by a vibrant acidity, which leads into a pleasant and persistent finish.
